**3. Minutes from the previous meeting**

Mr. Iacoboni motioned to approve the minutes from the January 21, 2026, meeting and seconded by Mr. Anderson, **The motion was approved unanimously.**

Mr. Gorski reminded Mrs. Stasko that extremely confidential information is discussed during these executive sessions, and said conversations should remain private and only discussed in that particular executive session especially personnel and current legal matters.
